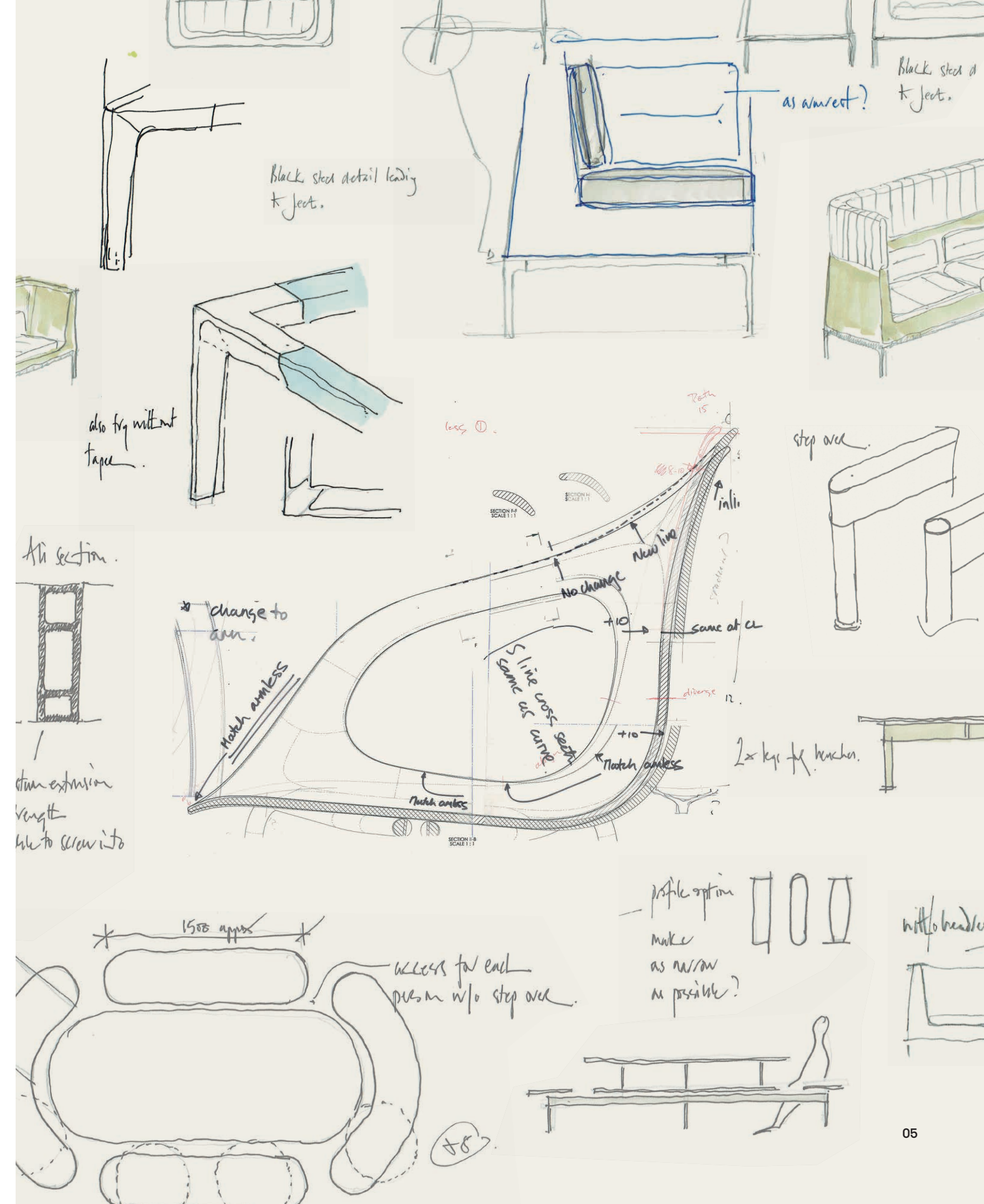

The beautifully simple polished chrome wire base offers a light functional structure, that allows the tables to work effortlessly in a multitude of environments.



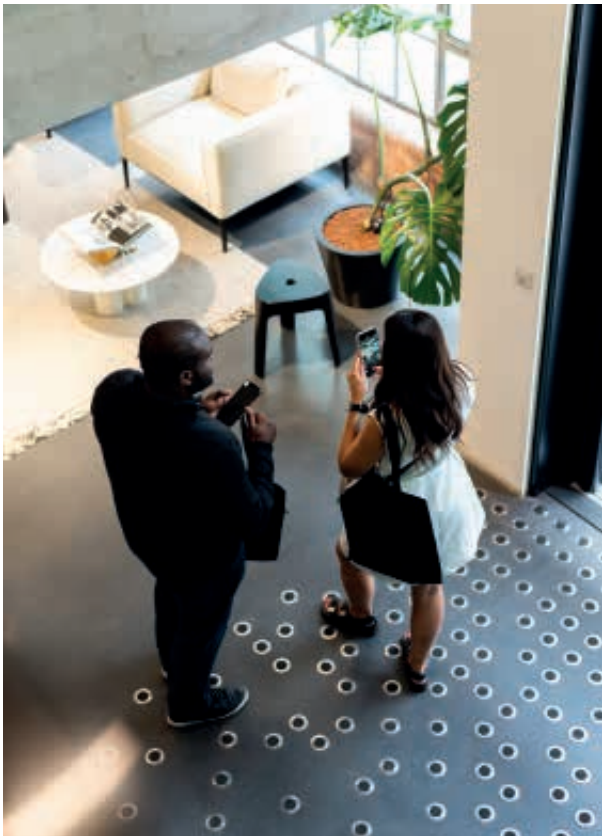

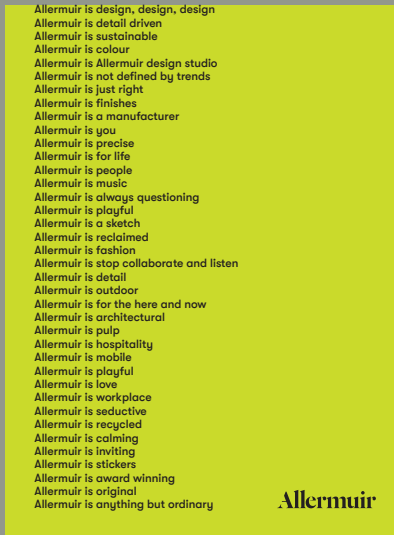

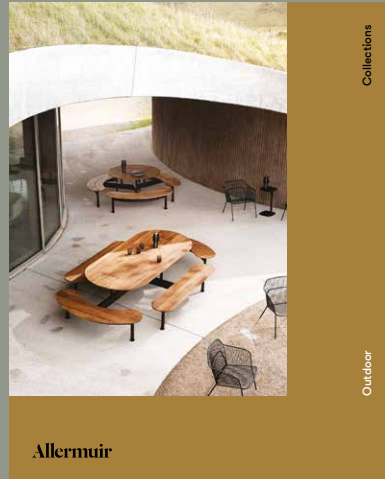
